- ❖ Player Development: Deep understanding of junior development pathways, with a track record of fostering young talent and progressing players to higher levels.
- ❖ Tactical and Strategic Acumen: Strong knowledge of the game's technical and tactical aspects, with the ability to enhance team performance and strategy.
- ❖ Strong Communication Skills: Excellent verbal and written communication skills, with the ability to engage effectively with players, parents, coaches, and the wider community.
- ❖ Organizational Skills: Ability to manage multiple programs and teams simultaneously, with strong organizational and project management skills.
- ❖ Budgeting and Resource Allocation: Experience managing cricket operations within a set budget
- ❖ UK right to work and disclosure checked.
- ❖ Availability to oversee training sessions (weekdays/evenings) and attend matches (weekends).
- ❖ Willingness to be involved in the day-to-day running of the cricket operations at the club and represent the club at external meetings and events.

The position is for a minimum of 20 hours per week over the cricket season (April through to the start of September) and for 10 hours per week over the winter months, remuneration is dependent on qualifications and experience.
