



Participants' Charter

Our aim is to remain an accessible and friendly cricket club at the heart of our community, where we all feel welcome.

This charter forms part of the Club's Safeguarding Policy, which is a condition of attending club events. It applies to 'participants' who are defined as club employees, contractors and players of visiting clubs and their officials, and the guests of home and visiting teams at the club's venues. .

Participants are asked and expected to:

- Show respect and courtesy to umpires, opposition players and guests and fellow members at all times, including on social media.
- Avoid criticism of umpires' judgement in public, particularly on social media.
- Recognise and encourage fair play and applaud good performances of both sides.
- Respect a zero tolerance of substance abuse, racist or homophobic language or behaviour or abuse based on a person's age, gender, sexual orientation or religion or belief.
- Consider wellbeing and safety of self and others before performance.
- Speak, in confidence, to Wanstead CC's Club Safeguarding Officer / team manager if you have any concerns.
