This charter forms part of the <u>Club's Safeguarding Policy</u>, which is a condition of membership and the participation at club events by families and guests. All members, both playing and non-playing, are asked and expected to:

- Show respect and courtesy to umpires, opposition players and guests and fellow members at all times, including on social media.
- Avoid criticism of umpires' judgement in public, particularly on social media.
- Recognise and encourage fair play and applaud good performances of both sides.
- Respect a zero tolerance of substance abuse, racist or homophobic language or behaviour or abuse based on a person's age, gender, sexual orientation, religion or belief.
- Consider wellbeing and safety of self and others before performance.
- Speak, in confidence, to the Club Safeguarding Officer / team manager if you have any concerns or are having difficulty affording match fees or subscription.
