## Players

## All players agree to:

- Be proud of your club and represent its name to the highest standard at all times
- Play within the spirit, as well as the letter of the laws of cricket and respect officials and their decisions at all times
- Play competitively but must respect their opponents
- Avoid bad language and any form of physical violence on and off the field
- Keep to agreed timings for coaching practice and matches and inform their Coach / Team Manager if they are going to be late
- · Practice the techniques and skills taught by coaching staff
- Wear suitable kit as agreed with the Coach / Team Manager. Protective equipment i.e. Helmet, cricket box, gloves, pads and footwear are compulsory
- Attend all training sessions
- All subscriptions must be paid by 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018
- Not to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club in matches or at coaching sessions
- Not consume drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club
- Not consume or attempt to consume alcohol

## Parents / Carers

### All parents and Carers agree to:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them at all times
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
- Not coach from the sidelines
- Never force your child to take part in sport
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept official's judgements
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport
- Use correct and proper language at all times and refrain from physical violence
- Offer help as required
- Refrain from buying age restricted products for under age members
