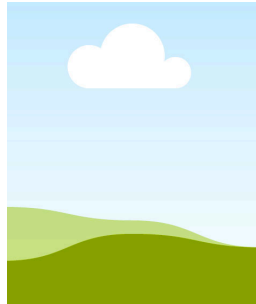

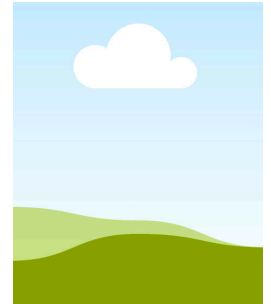

PARENT SUPPORT

Changes in 2025:

Any junior at U13 or above is eligible to play adult cricket, within these games boys will play with a range of abilities including ex 1st XI players, giving them a great environment for learning and enjoyment.

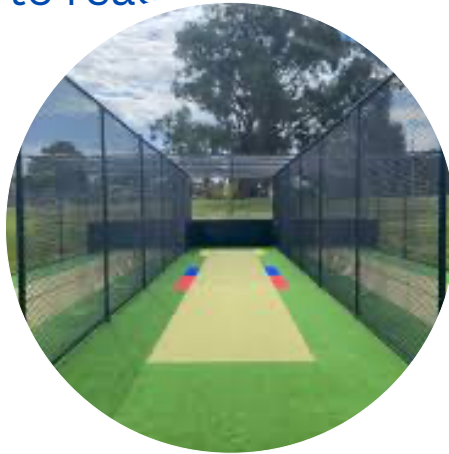
We would also love all of our parents who have played previously to pull those whites back out and come play with their boys!
