ESMBA Dress Code September 2023

Full dress regulations will be in force at all stages of the competition. Counties may opt for their own team tops, provided they conform to ESMBA standard, and ALL players are dressed the same, otherwise it must be standard grey/black and whites i.e. a plain white collared shirt and mid-grey/black trousers for men and a plain white collared blouse with either a mid-grey/black bowls skirt, crop or tailored trousers for ladies with either plain white or county colour sweaters, jumpers, cardigans etc. Only footwear manufactured by recognised bowls manufacturers may be worn on the mat and they must be changed into at the venue

Dress Code

As agreed at the AGM a dress code is being put together and will be put on the website.

Shirts

- Nothing on front except county badge which must fit into a 3" square grid.
- These shirts are for ESMBA organized events.

Trousers

- County badge on trousers must go on the side near the pocket within the 3" grid rule.
- No jeans or cargo pants.

Shorts

There was a discussion on wearing shorts and it was agreed that they will be allowed to be worn at **Open Competitions ONLY** as a pilot and a final decision will be made based on feedback. All team members must wear the same colour below the waist (black/grey) and they must be bowls or tailored shorts. If a player arrives in prohibited attire they will be asked to change.
