
## Nominations of Junior Players to Leagues


When a club nominates a child for registration with a league, the Play-Cricket system must email the parent to obtain their consent. Only once this has been received will the pending nomination become visible to the league administrator.

Here is an example of a record for a junior player and the club administrator is applying for registration to a league.





## Confirm the nomination:




Since the child is under 16 years of age, the system will automatically send an email to the parent(s) asking for approval. The status of the application will change to 'Awaiting Parent'.

The only option is for the parent to authorise the request.




View the nominations page to see the options available.




If you opt to re-send the email, then the nomination date will change to the current date.

When a parent has given approval for the child's nomination to the league, the notification will be removed from the 'Nominations waiting for parental consent' list and the application status will change to 'Pending'.
