




# GCR - First Instance Process



# GCR - Appeal Process



Decision handed down by Adjudicator or DP

Respondent submits Notice of Appeal (NoA) + fee to the DO of the Appeal Body within 7 days

DO appoints Appeal Panel Chair (APC) to determine whether NoA identifies sufficient grounds for an appeal

If RDPC does not accept the request, APC's decision stands and no further right of appeal

*Any sanction imposed by the Adjudicator, DP or AP will not come into effect until the appeal has concluded, unless decided otherwise*

If NoA accepted, DO of the Appeal Body notifies the Appellant and the first instance DO

If NoA is rejected, Appellant can ask the Recreational Discipline Panel Secretary (RDPS) to appoint a Recreational Discipline Panel Chair (RDPC) to review the APC's decision. Request must be made within 3 days of receipt of APC's decision

If RDPC accepts the request, they will decide whether the Notice identifies sufficient grounds for an appeal

DO of Appeal Body appoints an APC and Appeal Panel (AP)

If RDPC accepts Notice

If RDPC rejects Notice, APC's decision stands and no further right of appeal

DO of Appeal Body notifies parties of arrangements for the Hearing, including the identifies of the members of the AP

If RPC accepts the request, Review Panel (RP) is appointed

Appeal Body responds to Notice of Appeal

RP determines the matter based on written and/or oral submissions

If RP decides against Appellant

AP's decision stands and any ban applies to next match

Relevant Disciplinary Body responds to Notice of Appeal

Appeal Hearing

AP determines whether to allow or dismiss the Appeal

If appeal is allowed, case is concluded

If appeal is dismissed, Appellant can submit Notice of Review to the RDPS within 7 days and Review Panel Chair (RPC) will be appointed

If appeal is dismissed and Appellant takes no further action, case is concluded and any ban applies to next match

If RPC does not accept the request, AP's decision stands and no further right of appeal. Any ban applies to next match

Sanction disapplied or case referred back to RDPS for a RDP to be appointed to hear the case afresh

No right of appeal against RDP's decision
