Welcome! - About the BOCC

The BOCC www.bocccricket.com was first founded in 1925 but ceased playing in 1939 at the outbreak of World War II. The club was revived in 1986 at a time when there were only three active local cricket clubs in the Philadelphia area. There are now more than 30 clubs within an hour's drive providing a thriving cricket playing community (and varied opponents!).

We are proud to have consistently grown over the years since our revival to be one of the most active and best-organized clubs on the Eastern Seaboard. We presently boast some 50+ senior playing members along with thriving youth participation and programs. BOCC participates in the [Greater Philadelphia Cricket League](#) and [Philadelphia Metropolitan Cricket League](#) and for a typical weekend (April thru October) we simultaneously field one or two further teams playing in other competitions or friendly but competitive games. Continuing expansion has required more ground time than our original home ground at Cope Field in Haverford College could provide. In 2006 we made history by laying down the first cricket wicket in any State Park in Pennsylvania at Evansburg State Park and inaugurating our second home ground. In 2008 we laid a second pitch and converted them both to artificial wickets. A practice net was also installed some years later along with a storage shed late in 2022. All home cricket matches are now played at Evansburg State Park, and the grounds are maintained (by us – volunteers to help are always welcome!) to a high standard.

The BOCC plays cricket for fun, for love of the game, yet competitively, with a will to win. We place high importance upon members participating in social functions and volunteering effort on and off the field. There is a full program of social events throughout the year, besides the traditional post-game celebrations. Our Club is run democratically, by the members, for the members. Above all, the BOCC strives to uphold the notion of “cricket first, Club second, team third and the individual last!”

How to Join

- If interested in playing, come to nets at Evansburg State Park on Thursdays after 5:00 pm in the season or pre-season indoor nets. You may apply to join the club and be considered for team selection upon completion of membership form and receipt of appropriate payment.
- The BOCC runs a specific youth program with softball cricket for younger children and a partnership with 22 Yards Academy for a hard ball option for older kids. Further details on our youth program can be found at www.bocccricket.com or email our Youth Director at youth@bocccricket.com.
- Approval of membership applications is vested in the Club Committee; whose decision is final. If an application is rejected, all fees paid will be returned.

Disclaimers

Those playing at nets practice and matches agree to do so entirely at their own risk and while the BOCC carries certain insurance covering medical and property expenses, primary responsibility rests with the member. The BOCC expressly disclaims any liability for any injury to any player incurred during practices or matches. The club does not provide playing equipment - players are advised to secure their own helmet, gloves, box and pads, etc. Should any BOCC player cause a ball to injure any player or non-player or damage his/her property then it is the primary responsibility of the player directly causing such injury or damage.

Membership of BOCC assumes member acceptance to being a part of any BOCC social media audio or video publications. Any specific objections must be explicitly submitted in written form to the committee members. In such cases reasonable effort will be made to minimize publication, but club cannot be held liable given the nature of team sports/events.

Eligibility and Selection

- The BOCC is governed by its Constitution. All Applicants are expected to read and abide by the Constitution - see [BOCC Constitution](#). Two additional supporting documents provide details on club ethos, behavior on and off the field, and our governance structure and expectations. - Members are expected to conduct themselves as Gentlemen, on and off the field
- Membership does not convey the RIGHT to selection. While best endeavors are made to arrange forward fixtures to marry available demand, this is not a precise science, and any game may be oversubscribed on a weekend! Further, the Club Committee (whose decision is final) have full discretion to weight selection criteria according to playing ability, volunteer work on and off the field, regularity of availability, practice attendance and social participation. Note that league sides are strictly selected by merit and represent the best available players for each league game. Selection policy for other fixtures will be at the discretion of the Club Committee.

Notices

- The membership fee for senior players joining the club includes a set of BOCC logoed cricket whites, cap and tie (except for certain reduced fee memberships) along with a prepayment towards club social functions (waived for youth/reduced fee memberships). Youth memberships include shirt/trousers and cap.
- Members are strongly encouraged to purchase their own playing gear as the club doesn't provide it. However, the Club does maintain certain items of logoed club clothing for purchase.
- The BOCC maintains a website at www.bocccricket.com that requires registration and is accessed via a login and password. Upon your membership application being approved, you will be provided with access to this site by our Webmaster via registration. Instructions on making yourself available for games are posted on the site. ***Please note that all team selection and match availability activities are conducted via this website.*** Members are particularly asked to register their availability for fixtures at least a week in advance, **whether you are available or not.**
- **Note that the BOCC website is the official communication vehicle for the club and while there is an informal WhatsApp chat that is not endorsed by the club.**

- Beginners who wish to learn the game of cricket are welcome to join and players are generally helpful in the coaching arena – just ask! Playing members however will take preference in selection and those likely selected for upcoming matches will take priority in nets practice.
- Please note that **no alcohol** is permitted on any part of the Evansburg ground (including the storage shed), and such rule is strictly enforced. Please pick up after yourself and park in designated areas only while at Evansburg. Our good standing with the host authorities of our ground is of paramount importance to the Club.
- Players are required to arrive at matches **60 minutes before the scheduled start time and should be prepared to help before and after games in various duties as directed by the team captain.** Players must wear cricket whites for all matches except those subject to special league rules. Note that colored clothing may need to be purchased to participate in those fixtures.
- Failure to follow the guidelines in “Eligibility and Selection” and the “Notices” may lead to loss of playing privileges at the discretion of the Club Committee.

PLAYING MEMBERS: \$300 (after July 1 - \$200) (includes Club logoed whites clothing set, cap and tie and a subsidy towards club social functions)/RENEWING, \$250 (includes social subsidy)

FAMILY PLAYING MEMBERSHIP: \$300/\$250 as above for Father paid to BOCC with reduced fee of 50% off registration fee for each child enrolled as a youth member

STUDENT MEMBERS (High School and University with valid Student ID): \$200 (including Club logoed whites clothing set and cap)/RENEWING, \$150

Note: If potential new or current playing members are suffering financial hardship (such as being unemployed) there may be a reduced fee option available upon request subject to the discretion of the Club Committee.

VICE PRESIDENTS: Discretionary (a minimum of \$25 is customary)

MATCH FEES: Typically, \$15 per game for league games, \$10 for social games (reduced by \$5 for student/hardship) and payable to the match Captain.

Softball Cricket

The primary goal of the BOCC softball cricket program is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment where young cricketers can learn how to play the great game of cricket. The Program typically runs on weekends from April through September at the BOCC home ground located in Evansburg State Park at 528 Skippack Creek Rd, Collegeville, PA 19426.

Hardball Cricket

BOCC has partnered with 22 Yards to provide a specific hardball program for older school age children that provides coaching in a more structured and competitive framework using a hard ball. Coaching sessions will be conducted throughout the season at the BOCC home ground located in Evansburg State Park at 528 Skippack Creek Rd, Collegeville, PA 19426, with participation in organized tournaments also available.
